The six who participated this year totaled 1,058 laps in three days, or a record average 176 laps per driver. Putting in the most time on the track was John Andretti, nephew of former winner Mario Andretti, who drove 220 laps with a top speed of 201.974 mph.

Scott Atchison drove 210 laps,

with a top speed of 200.222; and Billy Vukovich III, whose grandfather won the race in 1953 and 1954, had 203 laps, with a top speed of 197.845.

Possibly the most surprising rookie is Harry Sauce, a county judge from Noblesville, Ind., who was turned down for the ROP five years ago but was given reconsideration

this year because of his experience in other racing, McCluskey said.

The other rookies are John Jones, former Canadian racing champion who drove 196 laps with a top speed of 199.071, and Finland's Tero Palmroth, who had 109 laps and a top speed of 201.027.

ing from Roberto's crash last week, it would be difficult to accomplish.

"However, we are supplying extra parts and a crew to further aid the Johncock effort. There's no doubt that the car will be competitive."

However, Johncock's first venture onto the IMS pavement since last year's 500 was short-lived. After a couple of warmup laps at speeds of 170 and 177, he pulled in with a trail of smoke after an oil seal leaked.

"The oil seal was leaking on the turbo," Johncock said. "It was also rubbing on the bottom. It was a rough ride and this place isn't that rough."

"We'll just go out and get the car working comfortably and hopefully put something together for the weekend."

While Johncock's appearance was more of a sensation than his speed, the two combatants for top speed honors last week were at it again Monday.

Mario Andretti had the day's quick speed with 216.763 in the Amoco/Kmart Lola/Chevy followed by pole-sitter Rick Mears with a 215.775 in the Penske Racing backup car using a race setup.

While all of the Penske cars which qualified Saturday were being worked on in the garage, Mears served as the designated driver in 1-T to gather data. Danny Sullivan is scheduled to take it out today, and Al Unser will drive it Wednesday.

Other top speeds Monday were Arie Luyendyk at 212.114 in the Provimi Veal Lola/Cosworth, Scott Brayton in the Amway Winning Spirit Lola/Buick at 209.594 and Tom Sneva in the Pizza Hut/WRTV Lola/Judd at 209.010. Sneva's time was not in a racing setup, however.

"I wish it was," the '83 winner quipped. "We ran full and empty, and it was as different as night and day. We have a gap to close."

Of those not qualified, Ludwig Heimrath Jr. was fastest in the MacKenzie Lola/Cosworth at 204.021, followed by Steve Chassey in the Gary Trout Motorsports March/Cosworth at 203.343.

The only major yellow of the day came when Harry Sauce spun 1½ times across the chute between turns one and two in the Conesco March/Cosworth. Sauce, who was trying to complete the final phase of his rookie test, came close but made no contact with the IMS concrete.

"The track is in good condition," Andretti noted. "It's very clean."

The National Weather Service's forecast for the Indianapolis 500 calls for mostly sunny skies with highs in the middle to upper 80s.

Teammates Danny Sullivan and Rick Mears, the pole-winner, were close behind Andretti in the practice period.

Sullivan turned a fast lap of 214.694, and Mears, who set one- and four-lap qualifying records of 220.453 mph and 219.198, respectively, was right behind at 213.118.

Others with fast laps on Thursday included Bobby Rahal at 212.811, Michael Andretti 210.981, defending champion Al Unser 210.035, Kevin Cogan 208.790, Al Unser Jr. 208.7 and Arie Luyendyk of Holland 208.6.

Meanwhile, the Penske-Andretti battle continued in the pits Thursday. In the annual pit-stop contest, Sullivan's car got four new tires and a simulated load of gas in 14.782 seconds. Andretti's crew needed 15.006 seconds.

Andretti qualified fourth for the race behind the three Penske cars of Mears, Sullivan and Al Unser.
